LANE CLOSURES AND TRAFFIC SHIFT ON EAST GRAND RIVER AVENUE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Wednesday, April 16, 2008, lane closures will be implemented on East Grand River Avenue in the vicinity of North Larch Street** to facilitate construction on the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project. There will be only one lane available for east and westbound vehicular traffic through the intersection Grand River Avenue and Larch Street. The available travel lanes will be shifted to the north-side of Grand River Avenue until further notice.

Motorists are being advised of possible vehicular delays with the restricted travel lanes throughout the duration of the construction in this area.

Lane closures and traffic shifts on E. Grand River Avenue are expected to remain in-effect until mid to late June. Updates on the schedule regarding these lane closures will be provided as appropriate.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
