### **CLOSURE OF LARCH STREET** **LANE REDUCTION ON SAGINAW** **DUE TO CSO 045 PROJECT**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces to facilitate construction on the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow 045 Project.

**Tuesday, April 29, 2008, Saginaw Street at Larch Street will be reduced to one eastbound lane.** During this lane reduction, the dual left turn lanes on southbound Cedar Street at Saginaw Street will be reduced to one left turn lane. Eastbound Saginaw Street drivers destined for locations east of Pennsylvania Avenue are encouraged to seek alternate routes as significant delays are anticipated.

**Larch Street will be fully closed to traffic, from north of the Shiawassee Street intersection to Saginaw Street beginning Tuesday, April 29, 2008.**

The posted detour for this closure is east on Shiawassee Street to Pennsylvania Avenue, then north on Pennsylvania Avenue to Grand River Avenue, then west on Grand River Avenue to return to Larch Street.

*This closure of Larch Street is expected to remain in effect until November.* Updates on the schedule regarding the closure of Larch Street will be provided as appropriate.

The lane reduction on Saginaw Street at Larch Street is expected to remain in effect through mid-June of 2008.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
