### TRAFFIC ADVISORY

#### **TRAFFIC SHIFT PLANNED FOR CAPITOL AVENUE**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that with the progression of the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) project the southbound vehicular traffic on Capitol Avenue will need to be shifted to the east for the next phase of construction.

The southbound traffic will be shifted from the west side to the east side of Capitol Avenue beginning on **Thursday, September 20, 2007.**

Once the traffic shift is completed it is anticipated that there will be a minimum of two southbound travel lanes on Capitol Avenue at the intersection of Kalamazoo Street.

During this construction phase Kalamazoo Street between Townsend Street and Capitol Avenue will be closed TO THRU TRAFFIC. There will be no access to southbound Capitol Avenue from eastbound Kalamazoo Street, nor access from southbound Capitol Avenue to westbound Kalamazoo Street.

This traffic shift is expected to remain in effect until mid to late October. Detours associated with this phase of the CSO project will be posted.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
