TRAFFIC ADVISORY **GRAND AVENUE TO CLOSE** **FOR CONSTRUCTION**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Wednesday, March 26, 2008, Grand Avenue will be fully closed to all traffic between St. Joseph Street and Lenawee Street and between Washtenaw Street and Ottawa Street** to facilitate construction on the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project.

In conjunction with this road closure, Allegan Street (the intersection of Washington Square and Allegan Street will operate as a FOUR WAY STOP) and Ottawa Street will be converted to two-way traffic between Grand Avenue and Washington Square in order to facilitate access to the South Grand Parking Ramp and the North Grand / Expansion Parking Ramp, respectively.

Eastbound and westbound traffic through the Grand Avenue / Kalamazoo Street intersection will be maintained throughout the duration of the project.

Posted westbound St. Joseph Street: Continue west on St. Joseph Street to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard; then north (right) on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to Shiawassee Street; then east (right) on Shiawassee Street to return to Grand Avenue.

Suggested Route for westbound Kalamazoo Street and Posted Detour for westbound Michigan Avenue: Motorists will be routed north (right) onto Larch Street to Shiawassee Street; then West (left) onto Shiawassee Street to return to Grand Avenue.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible. For additional information and construction updates visit: www.lansingcso.com
