URGENT --TRAFFIC ADVISORY

WATER MAIN BREAK TO REDUCE TRAVEL LANES **AT THE INTERSECTION OF HOLMES ROAD** **AND MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that due to a water main break in the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (ML King) and Holmes Road.

Around 7:00 p.m. Lansing Board of Water and Light crews will be closing the western most southbound travel lane on ML King north of Holmes Road and restricting and/or closing westbound Holmes Road to vehicular traffic west of ML King.

Westbound Holmes Road is being used as the Waverly Road detour for the on going utility repairs between Lochmoore Drive and Sheffield Boulevard. Motorist needing to return to Waverly Road will need to continue north on ML King to Mount Hope Avenue, travel west on Mount Hope Avenue to return to Waverly Road.

Access to all local businesses and residences adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.

Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes.
