URGENT --TRAFFIC ADVISORY

WATER MAIN BREAK TO REDUCE SOUTHBOUND TRAVEL LANES ON MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD AND CLOSE WESTBOUND HOLMES ROAD WEST OF ML KING

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that there is a water main break in the northwest quadrant of the Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (ML King) and Holmes Road intersection.

The Lansing Board of Water and Light water crews will be closing the western most southbound travel lane on ML King north of Holmes Road and restricting and/or closing westbound Holmes Road to vehicular traffic west of ML King. This repair should be completed and streets reopened by 9:00 p.m. this evening.

Access to all local businesses and residences adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes.

Suggested Detours:

Southbound ML King traffic needing to travel west on Holmes Road, should continue traveling south on ML King to Jolly Road, west on Jolly Road to Pleasant Grove Road, north on Pleasant Grove Road to return to Holmes Road.

Northbound ML King traffic needing to travel west on Holmes Road should, continue traveling north on ML King to Mount Hope Avenue, west on Mount Hope Avenue to Pleasant Grove Road, south on Pleasant Grove Road to return to Holmes Road.
