CSO DOWNTOWN CONSTRUCTION SCHEDULED TO REDUCE TRAVEL LANES ON CAPITOL AVENUE AND RESTRICT TRAVEL ON KALMAZOO STREET

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) construction will reduce Capitol Avenue southbound travel lanes and restrict eastbound travel on Kalamazoo Street.

Capitol Avenue has been reduced to one southbound lane and the traffic signal has also been temporarily removed at the intersection of Kalamazoo Street to allow for the CSO project. At this time eastbound vehicular traffic on Kalamazoo Street is being regulated with a STOP sign at Capitol Avenue.

On Friday, July 20, 2007 Kalamazoo Street between Townsend Street and Capitol Avenue will be Closed To Thru Traffic.

Access to business in the area will be maintained. Motorists should expect delays and are advised to seek alternate routes whenever possible.
