## **PARKING ADVISORY**

### **OVERNIGHT PARKING PROHIBITION LIFTED FOR THE HOLIDAYS**

To accommodate the expected influx of family and friends over the holidays, the City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the prohibition on overnight parking on city streets between 2 a.m. and 5 a.m. will be lifted **beginning at 2 a.m. on Saturday, December 22<sup>nd</sup> and continuing until 5 a.m. on Tuesday, January 1<sup>st</sup>.**

The prohibition will remain lifted during this time period as long as significant snow is not anticipated. If a snow event is forecast during this period, the overnight parking ban will be reinstated until streets can be cleared. To alert the public that a reinstatement of the overnight parking restriction is imminent, a news release will be issued to the media at least six hours prior to the reinstatement of the overnight parking restriction.

All other parking restrictions will remain in place, including the prohibition of parking a vehicle on street continuously for a period exceeding 48 hours.
