LANSING POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE HOSTING THE 15th ANNUAL MI-COPS MEMORIAL

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that Michigan Avenue between Grand Avenue and Capitol Avenue, and Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street, will be closed for the memorial procession between **6:30 PM to 7:30 PM on Monday, May 5, 2008** for the MI-COPS Memorial to honor the fallen police officers. Memorial is scheduled to begin at 7:00 p.m. on the east steps of the State Capitol Building.

Motorists are advised to seek these alternate routes.

Suggested detour route for southbound Capitol Avenue motorist is to travel west on Ottawa Street to Pine Street, south on Pine Street to Allegan Street, east on Allegan to return to Capitol Avenue. Vehicular traffic travel either north or southbound on Washington Square may encounter a short term travel stoppage as the Honor Guard and representatives travel along the parade route.

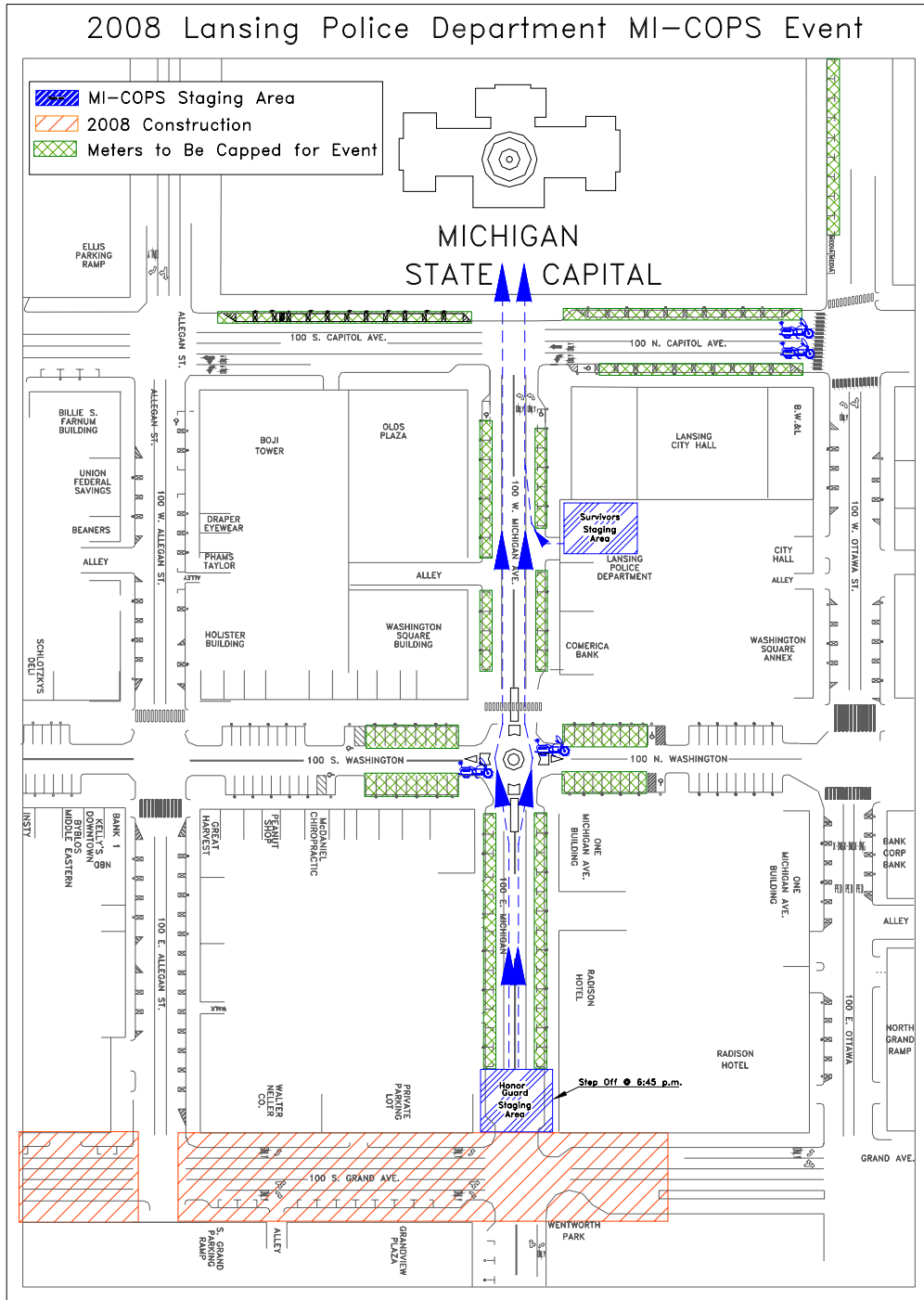
