## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD TO CLOSE BETWEEN MOORES RIVER DRIVE AND OLDS AVENUE**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the removal of the General Motors overpass will close northbound Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (M.L. King) beginning **7:00 p.m. Friday, August 24, through mid afternoon early evening on Sunday, August 26, 2007.**

Northbound M.L. King will be closed TO THRU TRAFFIC between Mount Hope Avenue and Moores River Drive and closed to ALL TRAFFIC between Moores River Drive and Olds Avenue.

Southbound M.L. King will operate under normal conditions during the removal of the structure.

Olds Avenue between southbound ML King and northbound ML King will also be closed to traffic during the removal of the overpass.

#### Detour Route:

Northbound M.L. King traffic south of Mount Hope will need to follow the eastern traffic shift and travel east on Mount Hope Avenue to Washington Avenue, north on Washington Avenue to Saint Joseph Street, west on Saint Joseph Street to return to northbound M.L. King.

Northbound M.L. King traffic needing to travel west at Mount Hope Avenue will need follow the traffic shift to the west, south of Mount Hope Avenue, travel through the Mount Hope Avenue and M.L. King intersection to the Michigan Left Turn Around at George Street then return to Mount Hope to access westbound Mount Hope Avenue.

Access to all local businesses between Mount Hope Avenue and Moores River Drive will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.
