### NATIONAL SEPTEMBER 11 MEMORIAL & MUSEUM TRIBUTE EXHIBITION TO BE IN LANSING FOR ONE DAY

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces that the ***National September 11 Memorial & Museum Tribute Exhibition*** will be in Lansing on Wednesday, October 10, 2007.

*On September 26, 2007 the National September 11 Memorial & Museum Tribute Exhibition opened for public viewing in Charleston, West Virginia. On Wednesday, October 10, 2007 Lansing, Michigan will have the privilege of hosting this traveling exhibition for one day. The traveling exhibition, which honors the nearly 3,000 men and women who lost their lives on September 11, is intended to raise funds and awareness in support of building the National Memorial & Museum at Ground Zero.*

*The exhibition tells the story of September 11 through photographs, artifacts and a short film from the point of view of families, responders, survivors, volunteers and everyday people who came together in the aftermath of the attacks. People from across Michigan are invited to come together again to pay tribute to the victims.*

The following lane restrictions to be in effect on **Wednesday, October 10, 2007 from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m.** in order to accommodate this exhibition.

The exhibition will be set up at the Veterans Memorial Park on Allegan Street across from the Michigan Historical Library and Museum. The display will be open to the public following the opening ceremonies between 9:00 a.m. and 6:00 p.m. on Wednesday, October 10, 2007.

The northernmost travel lane on Allegan Street from around 100 feet west of Butler Boulevard to approximately 400 feet east of Butler Boulevard will be closed for staging of equipment and needed supplies for this event.

The southern two lanes will remain open for vehicular traffic during this event. Drivers are advised to expect some delays while traveling through this area.



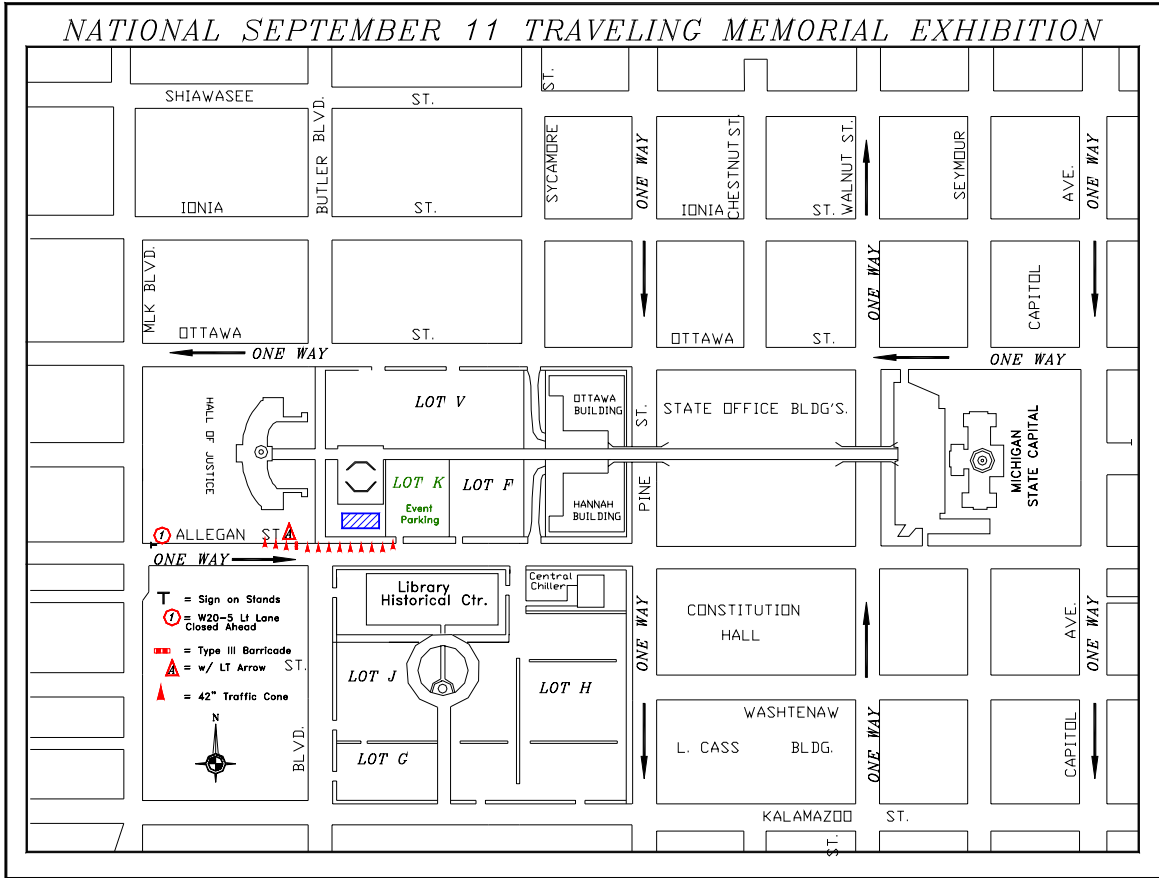
