### **BUILDING MAINTANENCE TO RESULT IN LANE REDUCTIONS AND TRAFFIC SHIFTS ON OTTAWA STREET**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that maintenance on the State of Michigan House of Representatives Building will reduce Ottawa Street to one westbound travel lane between 9:00 a.m. and 3:00 p.m. beginning on **Tuesday, August 22, 2007.**

This multi phase building restoration is expected to reduce travel lanes in this area through mid September.

During the first phase of work, motorist should expect reduced travel lanes beginning at Washington Square and continuing to Capitol Avenue on the north side of the street.

Access to all local businesses adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.
