### “Public Safety Career Day”

On Saturday, November 3, 2007, The City of Lansing's Department of Human Resources held a Public Safety Career Day. This event was hosted at the Lansing Police Department's South Precinct from 2:30 p.m. to 6:00 p.m.

Lansing's Chief of Police, Mark Alley, welcomed the group and provided an overview of the Lansing Police Department. Career presentations were given by Sergeant Daryl Green, Detective Traci Ruiz, Fire Training Captain John Stafford, and Sherry McDonald of the 911 Emergency Communications Center.



More than 100 people participated in Public Safety Career Day which highlighted careers in both Police and Fire Departments. Family fun activities included a featured clown, face painting, Safety Prints, a youth Police Explorer program, free popcorn, balloons and handout materials. A Lansing youth group, Dance For Life, gave two performances as a tribute to personnel who serve in public safety careers. Career booths at the event were stationed with representatives from Lansing Police Department, Lansing Fire Department, the Department of Human Resources, the 911 Emergency Communications Center, Lansing Community College's Police and Fire Academies, and CARE (Capitol Area Response Team who assists victims of domestic violence).



Public Safety Career Day is an informal event designed to educate the

community about the exciting opportunities within the Police and Fire Departments. It provides a positive message about serving our community. It serves as a catalyst to impact today's youth for future careers in public safety.
