PARKING SYSTEM CLOSED FOR HOLIDAYS AND FURLOUGH DAYS

The Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the Transportation and Parking Office will be closed from December 24th through January 3rd in observance of the Christmas and New Year's holidays and for budget furlough days between the holidays.

The North Grand, South Capitol and Townsend Ramps will be open throughout this time period. The North Capitol Ramp will be closed from Wednesday, December 23rd at 10:30 PM until Monday, January 4th at 6 AM. North Capitol Ramp parkers may park at any City owned parking lot or ramp free of charge.

Parking at downtown meters will be free during these days, though posted time limits are still in effect.

Regular parking operations will resume on Monday, January 4, 2010. Beginning January 4, 2010, the walk in hours for the Customer Service Center will be 8 AM to 4:30 PM, Monday through Friday. The Parking System will be closed on City observed holidays throughout the remainder of the year, but will be open during all remaining City furlough days.
