PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE TRAFFIC SHIFT TO BEGIN ON SATURDAY SEPTEMBER 1ST

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that with the progression of the Combined Sewer Overflow Separation Project 020 & 023, Vehicular traffic flow on Pennsylvania Avenue between Eureka Street and Saginaw Street will be shifted from the western most travel lanes on Pennsylvania Avenue to the eastern most travel lanes. This portion of the project is scheduled to be completed in about a week.

With the Lansing School District's first day of classes for the 2007 – 2008 school year scheduled to begin on Tuesday, September 4th, motorists attempting to enter the Eastern High School parking facilities may encounter delays and congested travel lanes. To reduce extended back-ups, it is being recommended that motorists approach Eastern High School by traveling eastbound on Shiawassee Street from the Cedar Street / Larch Street corridors.

Access to local businesses adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.
