## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE** **TO CLOSE FOR RESURFACING AND LEAD SERVICE REPLACEMENT**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the Lansing Board of Water and Light and the City of Lansing Public Service Department Operations and Maintenance Division (O&M) will be conducting utility work and street resurfacing on Pennsylvania Avenue between Mt Hope Avenue and Cavanaugh Road.

Beginning Monday, May 5, 2008 Pennsylvania Avenue will be closed to traffic between Mt. Hope Avenue and Lincoln Street for replacement of lead water services and pavement resurfacing. This section of Pennsylvania Avenue will be closed to through traffic. During this time O&M crews will be also resurfacing Pennsylvania Avenue north of Cavanaugh Road to Dexter Drive. Single lane closures will be used and traffic to the hospital will be maintained from Cavanaugh Road. This project will be completed in approximately 2 weeks.

#### **Posted Detour:**

Northbound Pennsylvania Avenue travel west on Cavanaugh Road to Cedar Street, north on Cedar Street to Mt. Hope Avenue east on Mt. Hope Avenue to return to Pennsylvania Avenue.

Southbound Pennsylvania Avenue travel east on Mt. Hope Avenue to Aurelius Road, South on Aurelius Road to Cavanaugh Road west on Cavanaugh Road to return to Pennsylvania Avenue.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
