CSO 018 SOUTHEAST PROJECT **TO CLOSE TRAVEL LANES ON PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Monday, April 7, 2008, lane closures will be implemented on Pennsylvania Avenue** to facilitate construction on the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project. **DURING THIS CONSTRUCTION PHASE**, Pennsylvania Avenue will be **CLOSED TO ALL SOUTHBOUND TRAFFIC** between Grand River Avenue and Saginaw Street. There will be two (2) northbound lanes of traffic maintained on the western most side of Pennsylvania Avenue.

The lane restrictions associated with this project will begin at Linden Grove (south of Saginaw Street) and conclude at Grand River Avenue. The detour for southbound traffic is to follow westbound Grand River Avenue to Cedar Street, south on Cedar Street to Shiawassee Street, east on Shiawassee Street to return to Pennsylvania Avenue.

The work on Pennsylvania Avenue is expected to continue until mid September. Further traffic updates with respect to this project will be provided as appropriate.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
