TRAFFIC ADVISORY

RAILROAD REPAIRS WILL REDUCE TRAVEL LANES

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that beginning on **Tuesday, October 16, 2007**, Norfolk Southern Railroad will be shifting travel lanes to allow for intermittent rail road track repairs.

Rail repair locations are:

Mount Hope Avenue between Lyons Avenue and Ada Street.

Washington Avenue between Mount Hope Avenue and Bank Street.

Channeling devices will be installed to shift motorist around the actual repair areas while maintaining vehicular travel in both directions.

This travel restriction is estimated to be in place for one to two days.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and to expect delays.
