## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **SOUTH WASHINGTON AVENUE CLOSED FOR 2<sup>nd</sup> ANNUAL MUSIC FESTIVAL**

The **2<sup>nd</sup> Annual REO TOWN MUSIC FESTIVAL - A SALUTE TO LABOR, A SALUTE TO YOU** will be closing Washington Avenue between Elm Street and South Street.

North and southbound vehicular traffic will find Washington Avenue closed beginning around 5:00 p.m. on Thursday, August 30, 2007, through Tuesday, September 4, 2007. Vehicular travel on Washington Avenue between South Street and Baker Street will be restricted to LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY.

Suggested detour routes:

Southbound Washington Avenue traffic will need to travel east at Elm Street to Cedar Street, south on Cedar Street to Baker Street, and then west on Baker Street to return to Washington Avenue.

Northbound Washington Avenue traffic will need to travel east at Baker Street to Cedar Street, north on Cedar Street to the Cedar / Elm Street turnaround (located just north of Elm Street on the east side of Cedar Street), using the turnaround merge onto westbound Elm Street and then travel west to return to Washington Avenue.
