CSO-DOWNTOWN PROJECT TO CLOSE WASHTENAW STREET BETWEEN CAPITOL AVENUE AND WASHINGTON SQUARE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that with the progression of the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) project Washtenaw Avenue between Capitol Avenue and Washington Square will be closed for the next phase of construction.

Beginning on Tuesday, October 23, 2007 crews will be installing a new storm water manhole at the intersection of Washtenaw Street and the mid-block alley. This portion of construction is scheduled to be completed in about one week.

Motorist needing to access businesses or streets east of Capitol Avenue on Washtenaw Street are being advised to travel either east on Michigan Avenue to Washington Square or east on Allegan Street to Washington Square.

Access to local businesses adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.
