The State's Christmas Tree will begin illuminating the City of Lansing night sky's shortly after the **11th annual Silver Bells in the City Electric Light Parade**, passes the intersection of Capitol Avenue and Michigan Avenue. The tree lighting will be followed by an explosive **FIREWORKS** display over the dome of the State Capitol
