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City to Update Property Values in Central City District

(LANSING) – Beginning March 31st, 2008 the City of Lansing Assessor’s office will be conducting a residential neighborhood revaluation.

“The revaluation of all property classifications should be done on a rotating basis, which means that 20% of each property classification should be physically reviewed each year for correctness,” said City Assessor Maria L. Irish. “This ensures that the assessor’s building data is correct and land values are at current levels.”

Irish noted that the organized review of property records has not been conducted within the City of Lansing for at least ten years. The residential appraisers’ will begin March 31st with the commercial appraisers beginning their review of commercial and industrial properties at a later date.

The neighborhood revaluation will include new photographs and the physical inspection and verification of the assessor’s data on all residential properties that fall within the approximate boundaries of: Beulah Street to the north, MLK to the west, Jolly Road to the south and the river to the east.

Appraisers will be wearing City of Lansing identification, which should be visible at all times.
