MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD **TO REOPEN TO THROUGH TRAFFIC** **WEDNESDAY, SEPTEMBER 1, 2010**

The City of Lansing Public Service Department announces that the Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) construction is complete in the intersection of Saginaw Street and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard. Northbound and southbound Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard will be reopened to through traffic on Wednesday, September 1, 2010.

CSO construction continues on Saginaw Street between Jenison Avenue and Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard where one lane of through traffic will be maintained. This construction is anticipated to be completed by early November.

Emergency traffic can use northbound Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to Oakland Avenue to access St. Lawrence Hospital.

The detour for northbound truck traffic on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard at Saginaw Street is no longer in affect. Northbound truck traffic can access directly Saginaw Street from Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Access to local businesses and residences adjacent to the construction will be maintained.
