LANE REDUCTIONS ON OAKLAND AVENUE FOR SCHEDULED CEDAR STREET CLOSURES

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Monday, August 17, 2009, N. Cedar Street will be closed to all traffic between Oakland Avenue and Monroe Street** to allow for City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow Control Program construction. In addition, **all westbound traffic on Oakland Avenue will be shifted to one travel lane on the north side of the street through the Cedar Street intersection.**

N. Cedar Street between E. Grand River Avenue and Oakland Avenue remains closed and it is expected to be re-opened to traffic in approximately three (3) weeks. The detour for this closure remains unchanged

The posted detour for the closure of Cedar Street south of Oakland Avenue is as follows:

Westbound on Oakland Avenue to N. Capitol Avenue; left (south) on N. Capitol Avenue to Saginaw Street; then left (east) on Saginaw Street to return to N. Cedar Street.

To maintain access to businesses on N. Cedar Street traffic through the construction zone between Saginaw Street to Monroe Street will be operated as a temporary two-way.

Updates on the schedule regarding these street closures will be provided as appropriate. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
