CLOSURE OF W. MT. HOPE AVENUE BETWEEN BRADLEY AVENUE AND WASHINGTON AVEUNE CSO 034B PROJECT

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Monday, August 24, 2009, W. Mt. Hope will be closed to through traffic between Bradley Avenue and the Railroad Tracks** to allow for underground utility construction consistent with the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Program.

Posted detour for eastbound W. Mt. Hope Avenue traffic: South on Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.; east on Holmes Road; north on Cedar Street to Mt. Hope Avenue.

Posted detour for westbound W. Mt. Hope Avenue Traffic: South on Cedar Street; west on Holmes Rd; north on Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd. to Mt. Hope Avenue

The Washington Avenue and Mt. Hope intersection is open to through traffic on Washington Ave.

Way finding signs have been posted for traffic and patients of Ingham Regional Hospital.

In addition to the above described closure, W. Mt. Hope Avenue remains closed to all traffic in the section of the street between Herbert Street and S. Washington Avenue.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained.

This closure of W. Mt. Hope Avenue is expected to remain in effect until mid-October 2009.

Updates on the schedule regarding these street closures will be provided as appropriate. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
