CLOSURE OF SOUTH WASHINGTON AVENUE AND GREENLAWN AVENUE INTERSECTION CSO 034B PROJECT

The City of Lansing, Department of Public Service announces that on **Monday, August 9, 2010, the South Washington Avenue / Greenlawn Avenue Intersection will be CLOSED TO ALL TRAFFIC.**

This closure is being implemented to allow for underground utility construction consistent with the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Program and is expected to remain in effect until mid-September 2010.

In addition, the section of **Washington Avenue between Mt. Hope Avenue and Greenlawn Avenue remains CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC.**

The following detour will be posted:

Posted detour for southbound S. Washington Avenue traffic at Mt. Hope Avenue:

Vehicular traffic will be required to travel east (left) on Mt. Hope Avenue to Cedar Street; then south (right) on Cedar Street to Holmes Road; then west (right) on Holmes Road to return to Washington Avenue.

Posted detour for northbound S. Washington Avenue traffic at Holmes Road: Vehicular traffic will be required to travel east on Holmes Road to Cedar Street; then north (left) on Cedar Street to Mt. Hope Avenue; then west (left) on Mt. Hope Avenue to return to Washington Avenue.

Wayfinding signs have been posted for traffic and patients of Ingham Regional Hospital.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
