CSO 034B PROJECT TO CLOSE SOUTH WASHINGTON AVENUE, BETWEEN MT. HOPE AVENUE AND GREENLAWN AVENUE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Monday, April 12, 2010 S. Washington Avenue between Mt. Hope Avenue and Greenlawn Avenue will be CLOSED TO THROUGH TRAFFIC.**

This closure is being implemented to allow for underground utility construction consistent with the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) Control Program project number CSO 034B and is expected to remain in effect until mid-August 2010.

The following detour will be posted:

Southbound S. Washington Avenue traffic: North of Mt. Hope will need to travel east (left) on Mt. Hope Avenue to Cedar Street; south (right) on Cedar Street to Greenlawn Avenue; then west (right) on Greenlawn Avenue to return to S. Washington Avenue.

Northbound S. Washington Avenue traffic: South of Greenlawn Avenue will need to travel east (right) on Greenlawn Avenue to Cedar Street; north (left) on Cedar Street to Mt. Hope Avenue; then west (left) on Mt. Hope Avenue to return to Washington Avenue.

Wayfinding guide signs have been posted for vehicular traffic to Ingham Regional Hospital.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
