TRAFFIC SHIFT - SAGINAW STREET FROM CEDAR STREET TO CLEVELAND STREET STARTING JULY 17, 2009

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the CSO construction will require the shifting of traffic on Saginaw Street between Cedar Street and Cleveland Street starting Friday, July 17, 2009 through mid September, 2009. Traffic will be shifted from the southern two lanes of Saginaw Street to the northern two lanes. The traffic shift shall take place after 9:00 AM. Two lanes of Saginaw Street will be maintained at all times during construction. Access to local businesses will be maintained.

The turn prohibition for trucks from eastbound Saginaw Street to southbound Pennsylvania Avenue will continue. The detour for trucks accessing Pennsylvania Avenue south of Saginaw Street is for eastbound Saginaw Street to turn south onto Cedar Street to Shiawassee Street, then east on Shiawassee Street to Pennsylvania Avenue.

Two-way traffic will be maintained on Pennsylvania Avenue. Traffic will be shifted from the west lanes of Pennsylvania Avenue to the east lanes in early August, 2009.
