**INTERMITTENT CLOSURES OF PENNSYLVANIA AVE AT SAGINAW  
ON MONDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2009**  
**TRAFFIC SHIFT - PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE AT SAGINAW STREET**  
**TRAFFIC SHIFT - SAGINAW ST BETWEEN CEDAR AND CLEVELAND**  
**STARTING SEPTEMBER 29, 2009**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the CSO construction will require the intermittent closing of Pennsylvania Avenue at Saginaw Street due to paving operations on Saginaw Street. The closures will be of short duration to allow for the final paving of the south lanes of Saginaw Street. The paving of the intersection is planned for off-peak traffic times.

Additionally, the City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the CSO construction will require the shifting of traffic on Pennsylvania Avenue between Shiawassee Street and Saginaw Street from the east lanes to the west lanes starting Tuesday, September 29, 2009. The traffic shift shall take place after 9:00 AM. Two-way traffic will be maintained on Pennsylvania Avenue.

Traffic will also be shifted from the north lanes of Saginaw between Cedar Street and Cleveland Street to the south lanes. This will also take place on Tuesday, September 29, 2009. Two lanes of Saginaw Street will be maintained at all times during construction.

The traffic shift is necessary in order to reconstruct Pennsylvania Avenue between Shiawassee Street and Saginaw Street. Access to local businesses will be maintained. Construction is expected to be completed by November, 2009.
