DOWNTOWN STREET CLOSURES DURING THE AFRICAN AMERICAN PARADE & FAMILY HERITAGE FESTIVAL

The *African American Parade and Family Heritage Festival* on **Saturday, August 2, 2008** will result in a number of downtown street closings according to the City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development.

Between 8:00 AM and 2:00 PM:

Allegan St. between M.L. King and Pine St. will be restricted to "NO THROUGH TRAFFIC";
Allegan Street between Pine St and Walnut St will be closed for Parade staging.
Butler Blvd between Kalamazoo St and Allegan St will be restricted to "NO THROUGH TRAFFIC."

Travel Lane Restrictions between 8:00 a.m. and 2:00 p.m.:

Walnut Street south of Washtenaw Street;
Capitol Avenue north of Ionia Street;
Pine Street north of Ottawa Street.

Streets Restricted to "NO THROUGH TRAFFIC" between 9:30 AM and 2:00 PM:

Seymour Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street;
Chestnut Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street;
Townsend St between Washtenaw St and Allegan St.

Streets that will be closing between 10:00 AM and 1:00 PM include:

Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Allegan Street;
Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Pine Street;
Pine Street between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street;
Allegan Street between Walnut Street and Capitol Avenue;
Capitol Avenue between Ionia Street and Allegan Street;
Michigan Avenue between Washington Square and Capitol Avenue.
