CAVANAUGH ROAD CLOSED

TO REPAIR WATERMAIN BREAK BETWEEN DONALD STREET and STABLER STREET

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the **Board of Water & Light (BW&L) will be repairing a broken water main on CAVANAUGH ROAD.**

CAVANAUGH ROAD will be closed to traffic between Donald Street and Stabler Street and will be restricted to LOCAL TRAFFIC ONLY between Cedar Street and Donald Street and between Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard and Stabler Street. The repairs are scheduled to begin around noon today and conclude around 6:00 p.m. Friday, December 5, 2008.

Motorist needing to access either Cavanaugh Elementary School or the south side of Everett High School should do so by way of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Motorists are advised to seek alternative routes around the road closure.

Access to all local businesses adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays.
