Capitol Ave between Ottawa St. and Allegan St:	from 7:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Pine St between Ottawa St and Washtenaw St:	from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Walnut St between Kalamazoo St and Ottawa St:	from 7:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Allegan St between M.L. King and Capitol Ave:	from 8:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Shiawassee St. between Cedar St and Capitol Ave:	from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Washington Sq. between Shiawassee St. and Michigan Ave:	from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.
Capitol Ave. between Allegan St. and Washtenaw St:	from 9:00 a.m. to 12:00 p.m.

Event Route:

Registration will start around 8:00 a.m. with the walk / run to begin at 10:00 a.m. on Capitol Avenue in front of the Michigan State Capitol. The walk / run will travel south on Capitol Avenue to Washtenaw Street, travel west on Washtenaw Street to Pine Street, turning north and following Pine Street to Allegan Street. Once on Allegan Street the walk / run will travel east to Walnut Street, north on Walnut Street to Ottawa Street, west on Ottawa Street to Butler Boulevard, south at Butler Boulevard following the pedestrian walkway south then east towards the State Capitol building. The walk / run will then travel north through the State Capital northern parking lot to Ottawa Street, east on Ottawa Street to Capitol Avenue, north on Capitol Avenue to the northern travel lanes on Shiawassee Street, east on Shiawassee Street to Adado River Front Park. The walk / run will loop around the park returning to Shiawassee Street at the corner of Grand Avenue. Heading west in the southern travel lane on Shiawassee Street to Washington Square. The walk / run will then travel south on Washington Square to Ottawa Street, west on Ottawa Street to Capitol Avenue then south on Capitol Avenue to the finish area.

Access to local area businesses, adjacent to actual event area, will be maintained during this event. Drivers are advised to seek alternate routes to minimize delays.
