GRAND RIVER AVENUE / TRAFFIC SHIFT **CSO 018 SOUTHWEST PROJECT**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that on **Monday, July 20, 2009, all vehicle traffic through the Grand River Avenue / N. Cedar Street intersection will be shifted from the north-side of Grand River Avenue to the south-side of the street** to allow for completion of water main construction in conjunction with the City of Lansing's Combined Sewer Overflow Control Project. **As a result of this traffic shift, southbound Cedar Street traffic will be prohibited from turning east (left) onto eastbound Grand River Avenue.**

This traffic shift is expected to remain in-effect for two weeks. Updates on the schedule regarding this traffic shift will be provided as appropriate.

The detours associated with this stage of construction are:

Southbound Cedar Street to Eastbound Grand River Avenue:

Southbound Cedar will need to travel east (left) on Lake Lansing Road, follow Lake Lansing Road to High Street, south (right) on High Street to return to Grand River Avenue.

Southbound Cedar Street between Grand River Avenue and Saginaw Street:

The detour remains as currently posted: west (right) from Southbound Cedar Street onto Grand River Avenue, South (left) onto N. Capitol Avenue, south on N. Capitol Avenue to Saginaw Street, then east (left) onto Saginaw Street to return to N. Cedar Street.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction zone will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
