CSX RAIL ROAD TO REPAIR TRACKS ON TURNER STREET NORTH OF REASONER STREET

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that crews from CSX Rail Road will be repairing grade crossings on Turner Street between Reasoner Street and Douglas Avenue.

These travel restrictions are estimated to be in place from Tuesday, August 12, 2008 through Wednesday, August 20, 2008.

Suggested Detour Routes:

Southbound vehicles on Turner Street will be required to travel east at Douglas Avenue to Old US 27 (Larch Street), south on Old US 27 to the Thompson Street off ramp, south on the off ramp to Thompson Street, south on Thompson Street to North Street, west on North Street to return to Turner Street.

Northbound vehicles on Turner Street will be required to travel east on North Street, under the overpass to Larch Street, north on Larch Street to Old US 27, north on Old US 27 to Douglas Avenue, west on Douglas Avenue to return to Turner Street.

Residential access will be maintained, but limited, during the repair operations. Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and to expect delays.
