## **URGENT --TRAFFIC ADVISORY**

### **REPAIRS TO DAMAGED FIRE HYDRANT WILL REDUCE TRAVEL LANES ON SOUTHBOUND CEDAR STREET AND EASTBOUND HOLMES ROAD**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that due to a recent accident the fire hydrant on the northwest corner of Cedar Street and Holmes Road will need to be replaced.

The Lansing Board of Water and Light water crews will be closing the western most southbound travel lane on Cedar Street and closing Holmes Road to westbound vehicular traffic. If needed the left turn lane from eastbound Holmes Road to northbound Cedar Street will also be restricted. This repair is scheduled to begin around 9:00 a.m. on Thursday, August 21, and is scheduled to be completed in about 4 to 5 hours.

Access to all local businesses and residences adjacent to the work zone will be maintained at all times. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes.

#### **Suggested Detours:**

Southbound Cedar Street traffic needing to travel west on Holmes Road, should continue traveling south on Cedar Street to Cavanaugh Road, west on Cavanaugh Road to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard, north on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard to return to Holmes Road.
