The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces the following street closures and lane restrictions will be in effect on **Tuesday, March 23, 2010** to accommodate the *Children's Trust Fund, Prevention Awareness Day, Kick off for Child Abuse and Neglect, Pinwheels for Prevention Campaign* event.

Street Closing and approximant times:

Michigan Ave between Washington Sq. and Capitol Ave: **from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

Lane Restrictions and approximant times:

Capitol Avenue Left Turn Only Lane for Michigan Avenue: **from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

Street Closing To Through Traffic and approximant times:

Southbound Washington Sq. from Ottawa St. to Michigan Ave.: **from 11:30 a.m. to 12:30 p.m.**

Event:

Event will consist of speakers on the east steps of the State Capitol, then a short march across Capitol Avenue down to Traffic Circle where event participants will plant the symbolic pinwheels.

Access to local area businesses, adjacent to actual event area, will be maintained during this event. Drivers are advised to seek alternate routes to minimize delays.

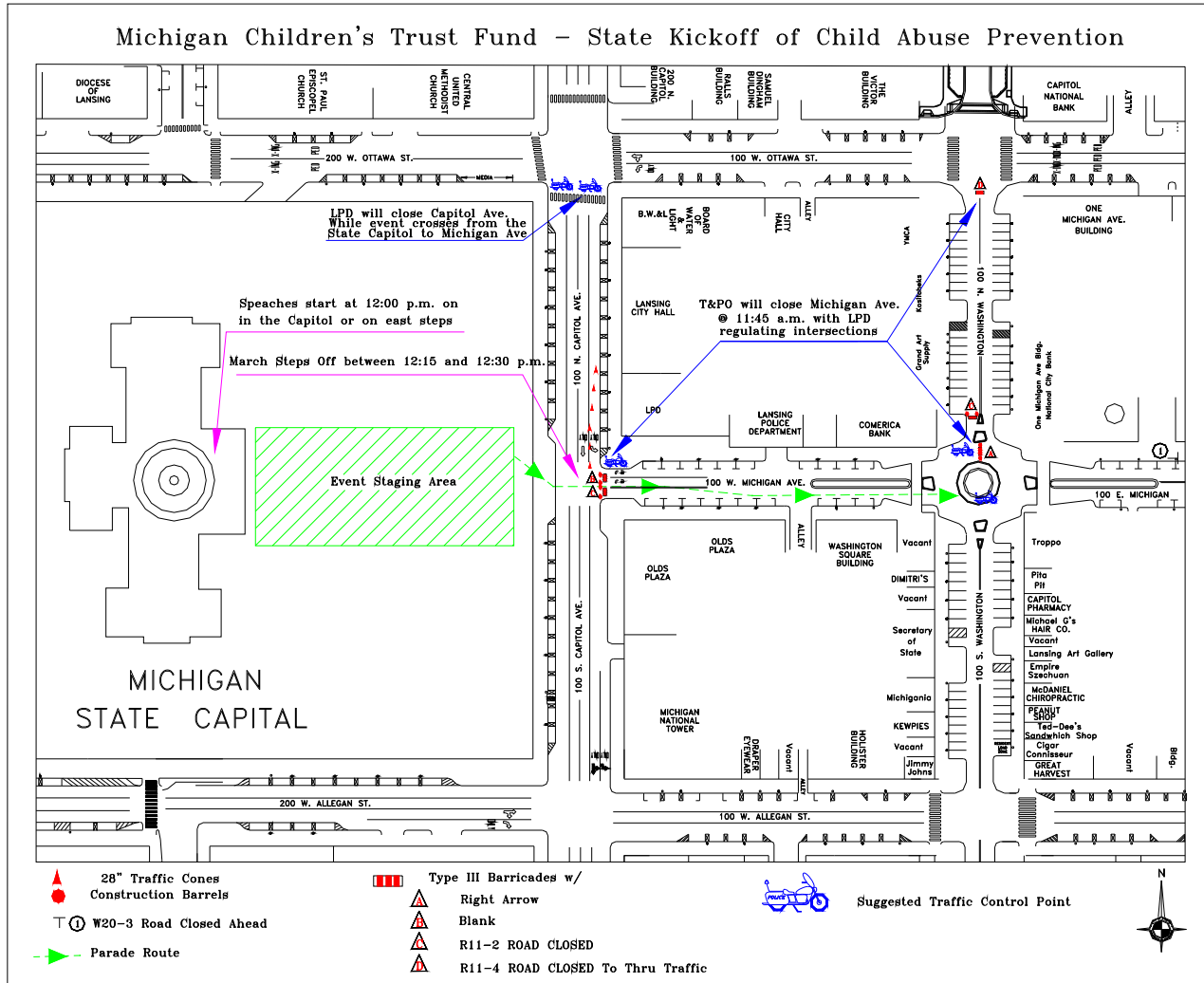
