SOUTHBOUND MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN OAKLAND AVENUE and SAGINAW STREET

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the **Consumers Energy will be working on the gas services at the intersection of Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (MLK) and Saginaw Street.**

Beginning on Monday, April 26, 2010, lane restrictions and street closures will be installed to accommodate Consumers Energy crews and needed equipment for utility work. Southbound MLK will be closed to vehicular traffic between Oakland Avenue and Saginaw Street. Access will be maintained to the St. Lawrence Campus of Sparrow Health Systems.

Suggested Detour Routes:

Southbound MLK north of Oakland Avenue and Oakland Avenue east of MLK:

It is suggested that southbound MLK and westbound Oakland Avenue traffic travel west on Oakland Avenue to Cleo Street, south on Cleo Street to Michigan Avenue, east on Michigan Avenue to return to Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard.

Access to local area businesses, adjacent to actual work areas, will be maintained during this project. Drivers are advised to seek alternate routes to minimize delays.
