## **TRAFFIC ADVISORY**

### **EASTBOUND MOUNT HOPE WILL BE CLOSED BETWEEN WASHINGTON AVENUE and TEEL AVENUE**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the **Consumers Energy will be working on the gas services on Mount Hope Avenue between Washington Avenue and Teel Avenue.**

With the completion of investigative testing Consumers Energy will complete utility repairs on Mount Hope Avenue. **Eastbound Mount Hope Avenue will be CLOSED beginning around 9:00 a.m. on Tuesday, March 30<sup>th</sup>.** This closure is expected to last through out the day to late afternoon. If additional time is needed, Consumers crews will return on Wednesday, March 31<sup>st</sup> to complete work.

#### **Suggested Detour Routes:**

##### **Eastbound Mount Hope Avenue and southbound Washington Avenue:**

It is suggested that eastbound / southbound traffic travel south on Washington Avenue to Greenlawn Avenue, east on Greenlawn to Cedar Street and north on Cedar Street to return to Mount Hope Avenue.

##### **Northbound Washington Avenue:**

Northbound traffic on Washington Avenue will need to travel to Baker Street, east on Baker Street to Cedar Street and south on Cedar Street to return to Mount Hope Avenue.

Access to local area businesses, adjacent to actual work areas, will be maintained during this project. Drivers are advised to seek alternate routes to minimize delays.
