TRAFFIC ADVISORY **CLOSURE OF EDGEWOOD BOULEVARD**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that starting **Monday, July 20, 2009 Edgewood Boulevard. will be under construction between S. Washington Avenue and Martin Luther King, Jr. Blvd.**

Edgewood Blvd will be **closed to all traffic east of Georgetown Boulevard and west of the Edgewood Villas apartments.**

Due to this mid-block closure, traffic on Edgewood Boulevard between Martin Luther King Jr., Boulevard and S. Washington Avenue will be restricted to local traffic only. Traffic on Georgetown Boulevard will be required to turn right (westbound) onto Edgewood Boulevard. Traffic entering onto Edgewood Boulevard between the Edgewood Villas and S Washington Avenue will be required to head eastbound on Edgewood.

To accommodate construction the following detours will be in place:

SB and NB Martin Luther King Jr., Blvd. to Edgewood Blvd east of Georgetown Blvd:

East on Miller Road to S. Washington Avenue, south (Right) onto S. Washington Avenue to return to Edgewood Blvd.

Westbound Edgewood Blvd to Martin Luther King Jr., Blvd.:

North (Right) onto S. Washington Avenue to Miller Rd., then west (left) onto Miller Road to access Martin Luther King Jr., Blvd.

Edgewood Blvd. (between Washington Ave. and Martin Luther King Jr., Blvd.) travel restrictions will remain through **August 2009**. Additional construction within this area will continue through September 2009 and further traffic updates with respect to this project will be provided as appropriate.

Access to businesses adjacent the construction will be maintained.

Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.
