To Close Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces the following street closures and lane restrictions will be in effect on **Thursday, June 24, 2010** to accommodate the *Michigan Education Association's Enough is Enough Rally*.

Street Closing and approximant times:

Capitol Ave. between Ottawa St. and Allegan St.: **from @ 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

Michigan Ave between Washington Sq. and Capitol Ave: **from @ 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

Lane Restrictions and approximant times:

Capitol Ave. between Ionia Street and Capitol Ave.: **from @ 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

Ottawa St. between Washington Sq. and Capitol Ave.: **from @ 7:30 a.m. to 3:00 p.m.**

Suggested Detour for Capitol Avenue: Southbound vehicular traffic on Capitol Avenue will be required to travel west on Ottawa Street. Traffic should continue west on Ottawa to Pine Street, south on Pine Street to Allegan Street, east on Allegan Street to return to Capitol Avenue.

Access to local area businesses, adjacent to actual event area, will be maintained during this event. Drivers are advised to seek alternate routes to minimize delays.
