### **LANSING POLICE DEPARTMENT WILL BE HOSTING THE 17<sup>th</sup> ANNUAL MI-COPS MEMORIAL**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the Lansing Police Department (LPD) will be honoring fallen police officers on Monday, May 3, 2010 at 6:00 p.m.

During the MI-COPS Memorial LPD will be closing Michigan Avenue between Grand Avenue and Capitol Avenue, and Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street, for short durations to allow the state wide law enforcement representatives to participate in a memorial march from Wentworth Park to the State Capitol.

Motorists are advised to seek these alternate routes.

Suggested detour route for southbound Capitol Avenue motorist is to travel west on Ottawa Street to Pine Street, south on Pine Street to Allegan Street, east on Allegan to return to Capitol Avenue. Vehicular traffic travel either north or southbound on Washington Square may encounter a short term travel stoppage as the Honor Guard and representatives travel along the parade route.

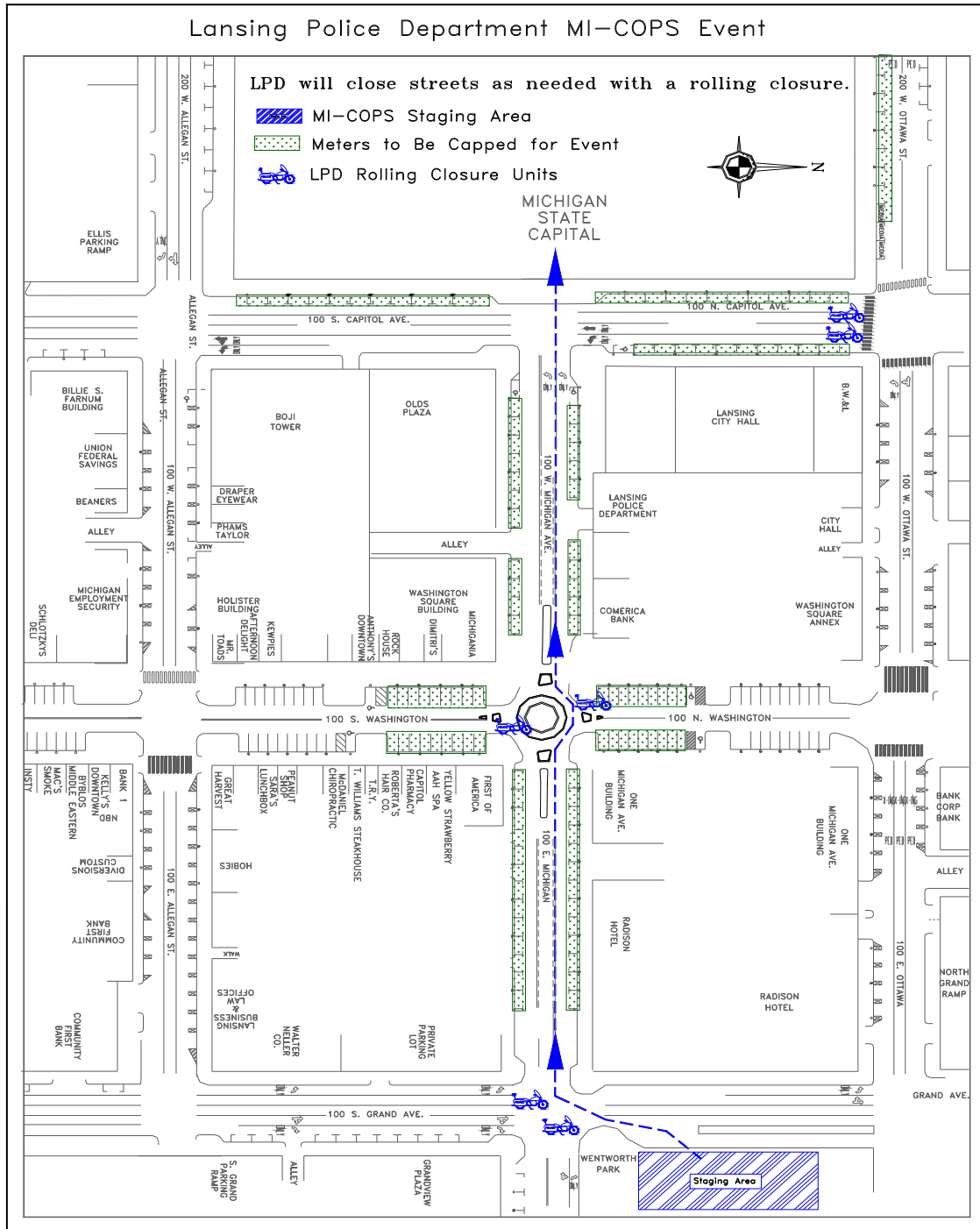
