NORTHBOUND LANE SHIFT ON MARTIN LUTHER KING Jr. BOULEVARD BETWEEN SHERIDAN ROAD AND TERMINAL ROAD

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces the Board of Water and Light (BWL) crews will be shifting the northbound traffic on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (ML King) to the center lane between Terminal Road and Sheridan Road.

Beginning Monday, January 11, 2008 the BWL crews will begin the installation of an underground utility vault on the east side on ML King. During this installation northbound traffic will be shifted into the center turn lane adjacent to the work zone. This lane shift is expected to be in place from 8:00 a.m. to 3:00 p.m. on Monday, January 11th and Tuesday, January 12th.

Access to businesses adjacent the work zone will be maintained.

Motorists are advised to expect minimal delays and be prepared to stop for entering and exiting of truck traffic from the excavation area.
