## TRAFFIC ADVISORY

### **WATER MAIN REPAIRS ON MARTIN LUTHER KING JR. BOULEVARD NORTH OF WILLOW STREET WILL REDUCE TRAVEL LANES**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that the Board of Water and Light reported water main break on Martin Luther King Jr. Boulevard (ML King) north of the Willow Street.

Board of Water and Light crews will be starting repairs and reducing vehicular travel on ML King between Theodore Street and Greenwood Street. Traffic will be reduced to one lane in each direction in the western most southbound travel lanes. Northbound motorist are advised to use caution as traffic will be shifted to the west.

This travel restriction is estimated to be in place for one to two days.

Motorists are advised to use alternate routes and to expect delays.
