CSO 023 CONSTRUCTION TO REDUCE TRAVEL LANES ON PENNSYLVANIA AVENUE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces that upcoming Combined Sewer Overflow (CSO) construction is expected to begin **Monday, March 19, 2007.**

On Monday, contractors will reduce travel lanes to one lane in each travel direction on Pennsylvania Avenue between Jerome Street and Eureka Street. This construction is to tie in utilities that were completed south of Eureka Street in previous construction seasons. Actual roadway removal and utility installation activities will be between Michigan Avenue and Eureka Street. **It is anticipated that construction within this section will continue through mid-May.**

In addition to lane reductions, **turn prohibitions will be in place at the intersection of Jerome Street and Pennsylvania Avenue.**

Motorists traveling northbound on Pennsylvania Avenue will be prohibited from making a left turn onto Jerome Street.

Motorists westbound on Jerome Street will be prohibited from making a left onto Pennsylvania Avenue.

Motorists traveling along Pennsylvania Avenue north of I-496 and south of Shiawassee street should expect delays. Motorists are advised to seek alternate routes whenever possible.
