STREET CLOSINGS and LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE DOWNTOWN BOYS SCOUTS OF AMERICA 100 YEAR HIKE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the following street and lane closures will be in effect on **Saturday, April 17, 2010** in order to accommodate the Boys Scouts of America, Scout Hike Celebrating 100 years of Scouting.

The below scheduled times and locations are estimated and may vary.

Street closures will be in effect between 8:00 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street,
Michigan Avenue between City Hall Parking Garage and Capitol Avenue.

Streets to have LANE RESTRICTIONS between 8:30 a.m. and 12:00 p.m.

Capitol Avenue between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street,
Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Walnut Street,
Walnut Street between Kalamazoo Street and Washtenaw Street,
Pine Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street.

Streets closures will be in effect between 8:30 a.m. and 11:30 a.m.

Allegan Street between M.L. King Jr. Blvd and Capitol Avenue,
Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Ottawa Street,
Pine Street between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street,

NOTE: Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Walnut Street will remain open but reduced to one westbound travel lane for this event.

Local access to businesses will be maintained during this event.

If access within the race route is needed there will be Lansing Police Department (LPD) personnel and/or LPD authorized personnel located at the intersections to help guide motorists safely to their destinations with minimal delays.
