STREET CLOSINGS and LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE FALL INTO FITNESS AND CAPITAL CITY RIVER RUN EVENTS ON SUNDAY, SEPTEMBER 28, 2008

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the following street and lane closures will be in effect on **Sunday, September 28, 2008** in order to accommodate the Fall into Fitness Events and the Capitol City River Run's Mini Marathon and 5K Races.

The below scheduled times and locations are estimated and may vary.

Michigan Avenue between Cedar Street and Grand Avenue for event staging: **6:30 a.m.**
City Market and the Lansing Center lower parking lots will only be accessible from Museum Drive off of Cedar Street. Access to Lot #55 on the east side of the Lansing Center will be from a designated travel lane from the intersection at Cedar Street and Michigan Avenue.

Additional lane restrictions / Street Closings beginning after 6:30 a.m.:

Pennsylvania Ave. eastern most northbound travel lane between Baker St. and Potter Park Zoo
Ottawa St. will be reduced by one WB travel lane between Capitol Ave. and Butler Blvd,
Pine Street closed between Ottawa Street and Washtenaw Street,
Capitol Avenue lane restrictions between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street.

Streets to be closed after 7:00 a.m. but prior to 8:30 a.m.

Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Ottawa Street,
Allegan Street between ML King Jr. Blvd and Capitol Avenue,
Townsend Street between Washtenaw Street and Allegan Street,
Washtenaw Street between Capitol Avenue and Pine Street,
Ottawa Street between Grand Avenue and Capitol Avenue,

Streets to be closed after 8:00 a.m. but prior to 8:30 a.m.

Capitol Avenue between Ottawa and Washtenaw Street,
Michigan Avenue between Grand Avenue and Capitol Avenue,
Washington Square between Michigan Avenue and Shiawassee,
Shiawassee Street between Cedar Street and Capitol Avenue,
Allegan Street east of Washington Square.
