### **STREET CLOSINGS and LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE COOLEY 5K RACE FOR EDUCATION**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the following street and lane closures will be in effect on **Friday, June 11, 2010** in order to accommodate the *COOLEY 5K Race for Education*.

The below scheduled times and locations are estimated and may vary.

**Street closures will be in effect between 4:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.**

Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street,  
Michigan Avenue between City Hall Parking Garage and Capitol Avenue.

**Streets to have LANE RESTRICTIONS between 4:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.**

Capitol Avenue between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street,  
Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Butler Boulevard,  
Walnut Street between Lenawee Street and Kalamazoo Street,  
Pine Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street.

**Streets to have TRAVEL RESTRICTIONS between 6:30 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.**

Walnut Street between Kalamazoo Street and Washtenaw Street (restricted travel),  
Washtenaw Street between Walnut Street and Pine Street (westbound only),

**Streets closures will be in effect between 6:00 p.m. and 9:30 p.m.**

Allegan Street between M.L. King Jr. Blvd and Capitol Avenue,  
Capitol Avenue between Allegan Street and Washtenaw Street,  
Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Ottawa Street,  
Pine Street between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street,  
Washtenaw Street between Capitol Avenue and Walnut Street,

**NOTE: Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Walnut Street will remain open but reduced by one westbound travel lane for this event.**

Local access to businesses will be maintained during this event.

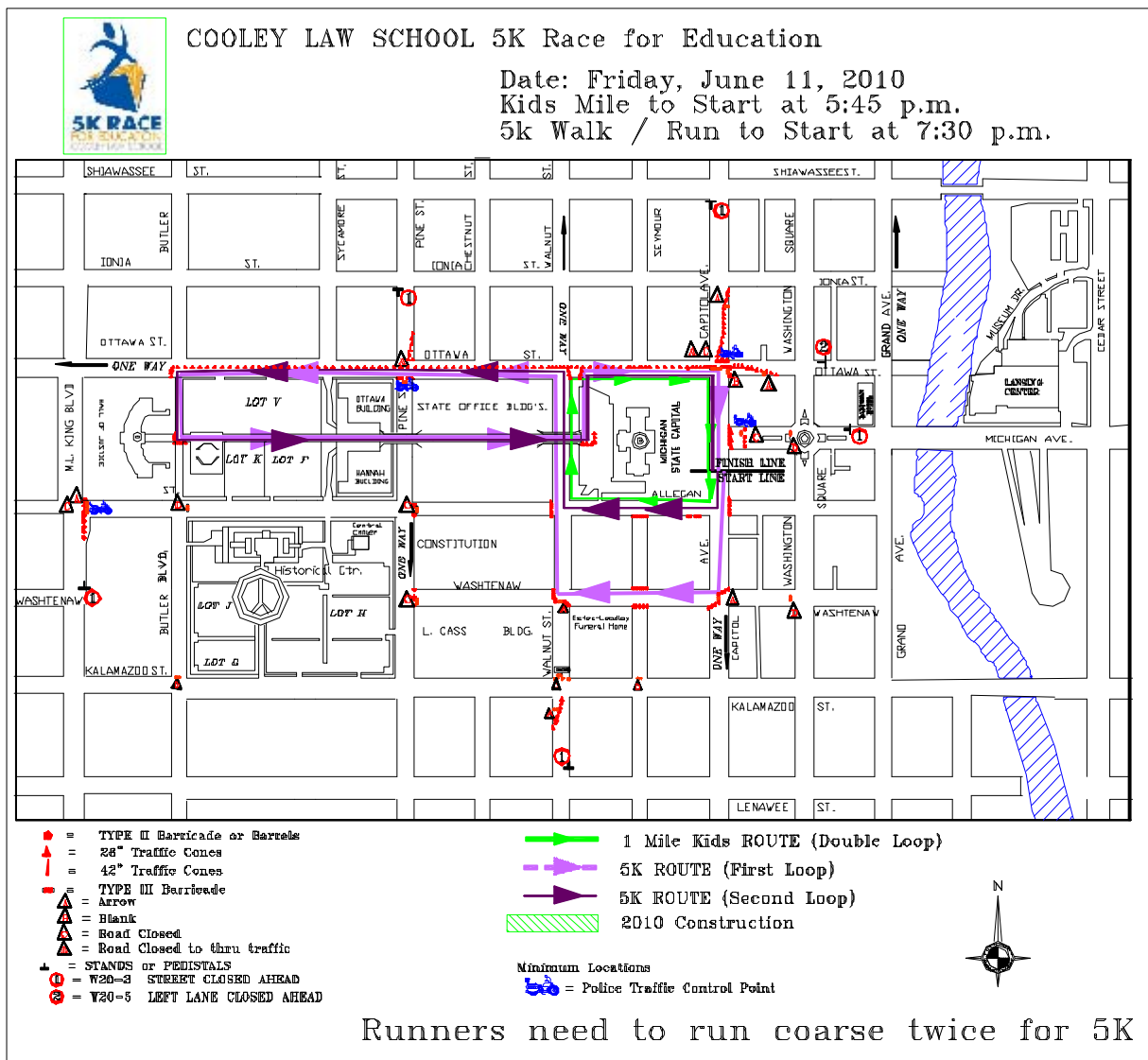
