### **STREET CLOSINGS and LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE INDEPENDENCE DAY PARADE**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the following street and lane closures will be in effect on **Saturday, July 3, 2010** in order to accommodate the *2010 Independence Day Parade*.

The Independence Day Parade is scheduled to step off at 11:00 a.m. With staging beginning around 8:30 a.m. at the State Parking Lots on Allegan Street across from the Michigan Historical Library and Museum. The Parade will travel east on Allegan Street to Capitol Avenue, north on Capitol Avenue to Ottawa Street then travel west on Ottawa Street to return to the State Parking Lots.

*The below scheduled times and locations are estimated and may vary.*

**Street closures will be in effect between 8:00 a.m. and 12:30 p.m.**

Allegan Street between ML King Jr. Boulevard and Pine Street.

**Streets to have LANE RESTRICTIONS between 8:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.**

Capitol Avenue between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,  
Walnut Street between Kalamazoo Street and Washtenaw Street,  
Pine Street between Shiawassee Street and Ionia Street.

**Streets with travel restrictions to Through Traffic between 9:00 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.**

Butler Boulevard between Kalamazoo Street and Allegan Street,  
Townsend Street between Washtenaw Street and Allegan Street,  
Seymour Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street,  
Sycamore Street between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street,

**Streets closures will be in effect between 9:30 a.m. and 1:00 p.m.**

Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Ottawa Street,  
Capitol Avenue between Ionia Street and Allegan Street,  
Allegan Street between Pine Street and Capitol Avenue,  
Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Butler Boulevard,  
Michigan Avenue between Washington Square and Capitol Avenue,  
Pine Street between Ionia Street and Allegan Street.

Local access to businesses will be maintained during this event.
