REINVEST IN AMERICA, KEEP THE DREAM ALIVE! **MARCH TO REDUCE VEHICULAR TRAVEL ON AREA ROADS**

The City of Lansing Department of Planning and Neighborhood Development announces the following traffic operations will be in effect from **9:30 a.m. to 12:00 p.m. on Monday, June 1, 2009** for the *Reinvest in America, Keep the Dream Alive* march and rally.

Lane reductions beginning around 9:30 a.m.:

Walnut Street south of Washtenaw Street;
Pine Street north of Ottawa Street;
ML King south of St Joseph Street.

Streets to close around 10:45 a.m.:

ML King between St. Joseph Street and Kalamazoo Street;
Allegan Street between ML King and Capitol Avenue;
Kalamazoo Street between ML King and Pine Street;
Walnut Street between Washtenaw Street and Allegan Street;
Pine Street between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street.

The duration of these restrictions and street closures will be determined by the size of the march.

Access to adjacent businesses will be maintained. Motorists are advised to expect delays and seek alternate routes whenever possible.



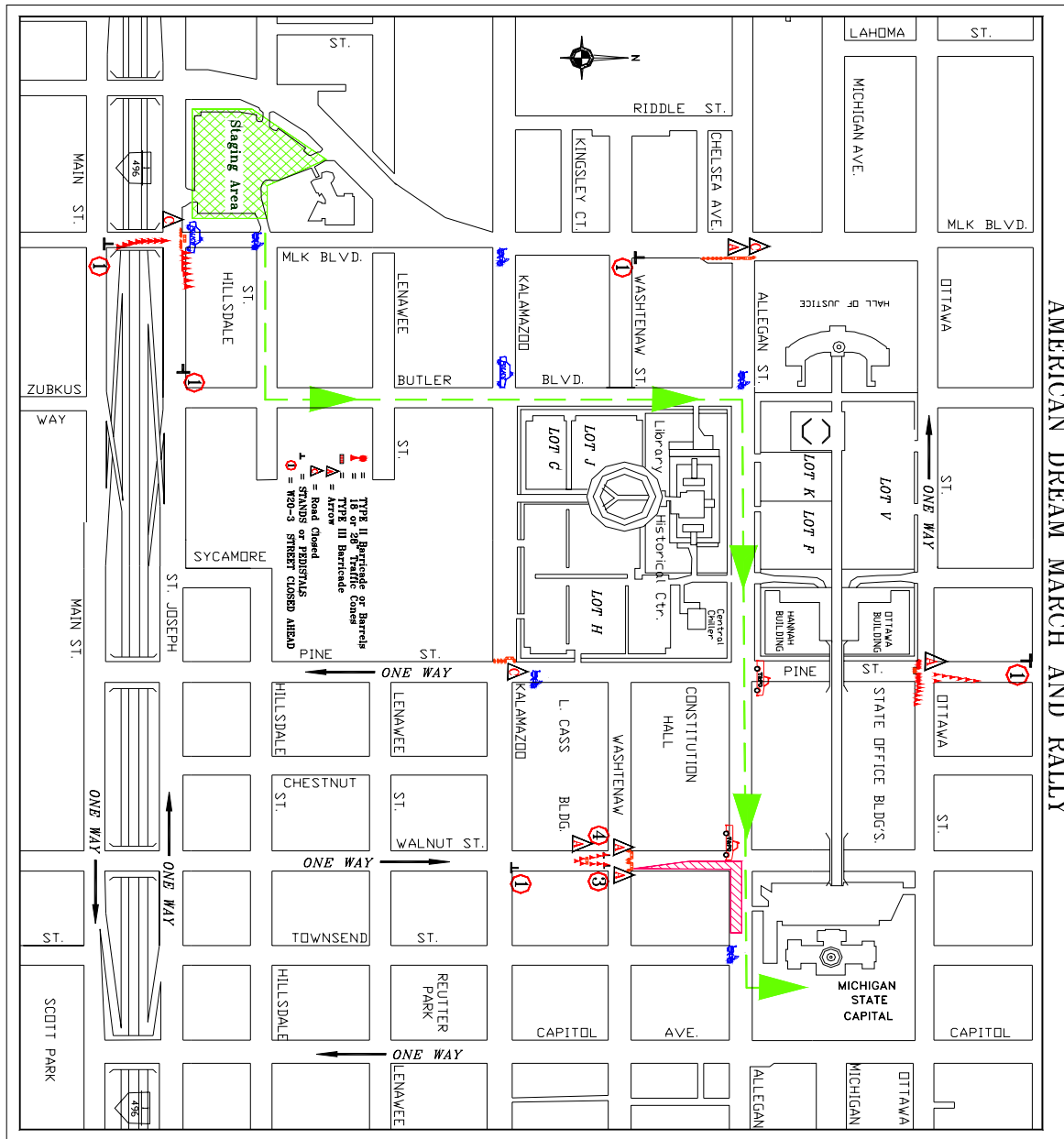
