STREET CLOSINGS and LANE RESTRICTIONS FOR THE GREATER LANSING KOMEN RACE FOR THE CURE

The City of Lansing Department of Planning & Neighborhood Development announces the following street and lane closures will be in effect on **Sunday, April 26, 2009** in order to accommodate the *Greater Lansing Komen Race for the Cure* event.

The below scheduled times and locations are estimated and may vary.

Street closures will be in effect between 9:00 a.m. and 5:30 p.m.

Capitol Avenue between Ottawa Street and Allegan Street,
Michigan Avenue between Washington Square and Capitol Avenue.

Streets to have LANE RESTRICTIONS between 9:30 a.m. and 4:00 p.m.

Capitol Avenue between Ionia Street and Ottawa Street,
Eastern and western most southbound travel lanes north of Shiawassee St. on Capitol Ave.

Streets to be restricted or closed to vehicular traffic between 12:00 p.m. and 3:30 p.m.

Allegan Street between ML King Jr. Boulevard and Capitol Avenue,
Butler Boulevard between Kalamazoo Street and Allegan Street,
Capitol Avenue between Allegan Street and Kalamazoo Street,
Chestnut Street between Lenawee Street and Kalamazoo Street,
Pine Street between Ottawa Street and Kalamazoo Street,
Townsend Street between Lenawee Street and Allegan Street,
Washtenaw Street between Washington Square and Pine Street,
Walnut Street between Lenawee Street and Ottawa Street.

Streets to be restricted or closed to vehicular traffic between 1:00 p.m. and 4:30 p.m.

Butler Boulevard between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Capitol Avenue between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Chestnut Street between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Pine Street between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Seymour Street between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Sycamore Street between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street,
Walnut Street between Shiawassee Street and Ottawa Street.

Streets to be restricted or closed to vehicular traffic between 1:30 p.m. and 3:00 p.m.

Kalamazoo Street between Capitol Avenue and Pine Street,
Ionia Street between Washington Square and ML King Jr. Boulevard,
Ottawa Street between Washington Square and Butler Boulevard.

Local access to businesses will be maintained during this event.

If access within the race route is needed there will be Lansing Police Department (LPD) personnel and/or LPD authorized personnel located at the intersections to help guide motorists safely to their destinations with minimal delays. If you would like to contact LPD please call Sergeant Leith Curtis at 483-4667 Monday through Friday during normal business hours.

The 5K race/walk portion of this event is scheduled to start at 2:00 p.m. Final street closings are scheduled to take place approximately 1:30 p.m. after the morning religious services have been completed. It is suggested that motorists and/or parishioners north of Allegan Street travel north towards Shiawassee Street to exit the area and motorists south of Allegan Street travel south past Kalamazoo Street.



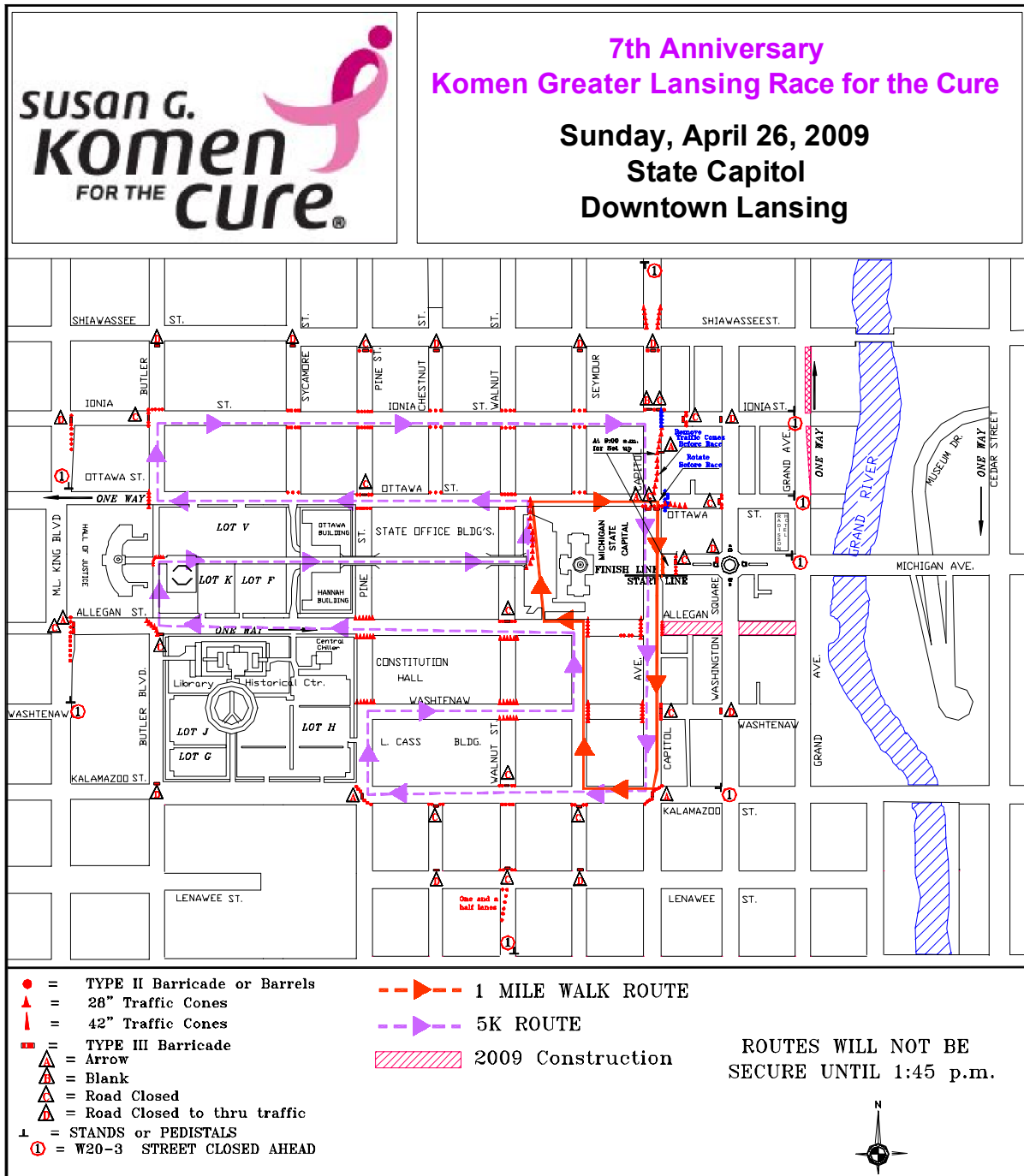
